2014 SCFU Novice and intermediates

Jill Farmer reports on a busy competition which took place at Wimbledon College on the 30th November 2014

It was a very well attended event with fencers from nine clubs from all over the county. Fencers could enter foil, epee or sabre, at either Novice or Intermediate level. The novice and intermediate foil ran in the morning, whilst the epee and sabre ran concurrently in the afternoon.

The foil and epee events were run as first-round pools, followed by direct-elimination tableaux. The novice epee was mixed (1 woman and 9 men). The women's sabre was fenced as a poule unique (3 fencers), whilst the men's novice and intermediate sabre ran as a combined pool, followed by direct elimination.

Wimbledon College sports hall was booked from 9am until 6pm. The competition and medal presentations ended a little before 5.30pm.

The SE Men's and Women's epee championships were held at the Kent and Canterbury University on Sunday 11th January 2015.

In the Men's event there was an entry of 32 fencers from clubs across the region. From the first round of 5 pools, Cameron Prior from Gravesham emerged as the top seed with Adam Whitelaw from Eltham College as 2nd. Cameron progressed to the last 4 where he lost to Tim Buzwell from Wimbledon. Adam reached the last 8 where he lost to Niall Campbell from Redhill & Reigate. Niall in turn lost to Ralph Johnson from Tenterden in the last 4, to set up a final between the 2 vets, from which Ralph emerged victorious.

The John Fairhall Trophy is awarded to the top under 20 fencer in the Men's event

and this year the recipient was Cameron Prior from Gravesham.

Medals are also awarded to the top intermediate fencers from the final rankings, this years winner was Hugo Smith from Kings Canterbury, with Tyler Lucas from Maidstone 2nd and Mark Harrison from the Unversity and Will East from Kings Rochester sharing the bronze medals.

In the Women's event there were 12 fencers divided into 2 pools for the first round. Nicola Hull from Dream FC and last years winner emerged as top seed and Holly Snellin 2nd. Holly was beaten in the last 4 by Eleanor Harvie from Crawley, the number 3 seed. Nicola progressed all the way to the final with Eleanor and emerged victorious once again to win the Women's event.


Surrey One hit épée
