

- 4. Teams are of three fencers (with optional 4th reserve). You may substitute a reserve during a match if you wish provided they were nominated (record on pool sheet) before the match starts. If there is sufficient interest in advance for a separate ladies team event then that may be arranged.
- 5. Referee: If your club can bring a referee, this will help the smooth running of the competition.
- 6. Kit: You must bring your kit in good working order and in a safe condition. The organiser reserves the right to refuse to allow a fencer to compete in kit he considers to be unsafe. Plastrons are mandatory.
- 7. All fencers must be age 13 years or over before 1st January in the season of the event. The season runs from 1st September to 31st August.
- 8. All fencers must participate in accordance with BFA Safety Guidelines (see BFA website).
- 9. Blade size restrictions: N/A (size 5 weapons allowed)
- 10. Please do bring you own provisions but do not consume or spill sticky drinks in the sports hall. Your entry fee does not include cleaning of the sports hall; we are relying on no one spilling any food or drink.
- 11. **Disclaimer:** All fencers are reminded that they compete at their own risk. The organisers will take all reasonable care, but do not accept liability for loss or injury, howsoever caused. For Under 18 competitors a parent or guardian must sign the entry form. If you are under 18 and object to photography then consult the organiser.


Nearest stations are Gomshall or Dorking (more trains). Arrange <u>taxi</u> before travelling (Gomshall is about 3miles from the venue along country lanes (i.e. walking not advised, consider a <u>taxi</u> from <u>Dorking!</u>).

<u>Road Directions:</u> Please bring a good map. Do not rely on these small extracts. Heading west towards Guildford from Dorking on the A25, turn left along Hollow Lane approximately 0.5m after passing the Wotton Hatch Pub.

Heading east towards Dorking from Guildford, about 1.2m after passing through Abinger Hammer, turn right along Hollow Lane.

Follow Hollow Lane for about 1.4m. Then turn right along Pasture Wood Road. The school is about 0.6m along this road on the right hand side.

As you enter the school grounds, follow the drive round to the right. As you go down the hill there is a short gravel drive up to the left leading to the entrance to the sports centre. PLEASE DO NOT park here -this will be reserved for organisers bringing equipment in etc. There is plenty of car parking space just down the hill to the right, or just up the hill back toward the entrance on the right.
