

Foil Team Championships

- 1. Entry form available via: http://www.surreyfencing.com/Entry_Surrey_Foil_Team.html
 Please post paper form with cheque (to Jill Farmer, 24 Wellington Road, Wimbledon Park, London SW19 8EQ).
 Ideally also submit on-line. Online entries after noon on Sat 27th might not be read.
- 2. Venue: <u>Tooting Graveney School</u>, Welham Road, Tooting, <u>SW17 9BU</u> (1.2km ESE from Tooting Broadway Tube). Sports Hall is to the South of Welham Rd, behind the lower school. (Venue is booked 9am-5pm).



- 3. Report by Time: 9:30am (same time for men and women to allow events to combine if one is small). Please remember the **clock change**.
- 4. BFA Cards: All team members to bring your British Fencing Association membership card with you.
- 5. Teams are of three fencers. You may substitute a reserve during a match if you wish provided they were nominated (record on pool sheet) before the match starts. If there is sufficient interest in a separate womens team event then that may be arranged.
- 6. Referee: If your club can bring a referee, this will help the smooth running of the competition.
- 7. Kit: You must bring your kit in good working order and in a safe condition. The organiser reserves the right to refuse to allow a fencer to compete in kit he considers to be unsafe. Plastrons are mandatory.
- 8. All fencers must participate in accordance with BFA Safety Guidelines (see www.BritishFencing.com).
- 9. Age restriction: All fencers must be age 13 years or over before 1st January in the season of the event. The season runs from 1st September to 31st August.
- 10. Blade size restrictions: Any size in the range 0 to 5 allowed.
- 11. Please do bring your own provisions but do not consume or spill sticky drinks in the sports hall. Your entry fee does not include cleaning of the sports hall; we are relying on no one spilling any food or drink.
- 12. Disclaimer: All fencers are reminded that they compete at their own risk. The organisers will take all reasonable care, but do not accept liability for loss or injury, howsoever caused. For Under 18 competitors a parent or guardian must sign the entry form. If you are under 18 and object to photography then consult the organiser.
