- 2. Venue: Sports Hall, Epsom College, Longdown Lane, Epsom, KT17 4JQ
- 3. Report by Time: 9:30am (same time for men and women to allow events to combine if one is small).
- 4. BF Membership: All team members to bring evidence of your British Fencing membership.
- 5. Teams are of three fencers. You may substitute a reserve during a match if you wish provided they were nominated (record on pool sheet) before the match starts. If there is sufficient interest in a separate women's team event then that may be arranged.
- 6. Referee: If your club can bring a referee, this will help the smooth running of the competition.
- 7. Kit: You must bring your kit in good working order and in a safe condition. The organiser reserves the right to refuse to allow a fencer to compete in kit he considers to be unsafe. Plastrons (rated for at least the 800Newtons level, i.e. CEN2) are mandatory. Regulation gloves required..
- 8. All fencers must participate in accordance with BF Safety Guidelines (see <a href="www.BritishFencing.com">www.BritishFencing.com</a>).
- 9. Age restriction: All fencers must be age 13 years or over before 1st January in the season of the event. The season runs from 1st September to 31st August.
- 10. Blade size restrictions: Any size in the range 0 to 5 allowed.
- 11. Please do bring your own provisions but do not consume or spill sticky drinks in the sports hall. Your entry fee does not include cleaning of the sports hall; we are relying on no one spilling any food or drink.
- 12. Disclaimer: All fencers are reminded that they compete at their own risk. The organisers will take all reasonable care, but do not accept liability for loss or injury, howsoever caused. For Under 18 competitors a parent or guardian must sign the entry form. If you need us to restrict photography / published identification then consult the organiser (or J. Hamilton, SCFU Safeguarding).
- 13. Preferably arrive already changed to reduce changing room segregation issues.
